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# GENERAL INFORMATION

## SECURITY & DROP OFF

Security - It is our desire to ensure the safety of every camper here at Northside. For this reason, we ask that you **drop-off** your camper in the following areas, making sure that he/she has checked in **before** you leave the property:

### • SUMMER DAY CAMP

**6:30 - 7:30**-A.E.L. Building

**7:30 - 8:30** - Playground/ Upstairs A-Wing on rainy mornings.

Please look for the flags posted at either entrance.

**8:30 - 9:00** - Cafeteria for Snack

**\*Once doors lock at 9:00, you must enter through C-wing (main school entrance)**

A Camp Counselor will be at the main gate of the playground to check your camper in.

\*\*\*Please make sure your camper has signed in with the counselor before going to play.

\*\*\*If your child's group is inside at the time you are dropping off, please escort your child to their class.

## SECURITY - FLAG COLORS

**FLAGS** - Parents, please look for the appropriate flag when dropping off or picking up your camper. Location flags may be posted outside of A-Wing, B-Wing, Playground, Fine Arts Center, Main Gym, or AEL. If you are unsure of your camper's location, please stop by the front desk at the AEL Building.

## FLAG COLORS

- RED - Rising 1st & 2nd GRADE
- GREEN - Rising 3rd & 4th GRADE
- ORANGE - Rising 5th, 6th, & 7th GRADE

## SWIM DAY

**Swim Day** – Please refer to the following chart for your child’s swim day. Girls should wear a modest one-piece bathing suit or a tankini that covers their stomach. Please remember to label ALL of your camper’s belongings – including swim items. **(DON’T FORGET YOUR SUNSCREEN & TOWEL!)**

**Field Trips** – Students will typically participate in two off campus Field Trips per week. You will receive a summer calendar of events. If items from home are needed for the trip, it will be listed on the calendar.

## ITEMS FROM HOME

**Items from home** – Northside Summer Day Camp will not be responsible for any items your camper brings from home. Please make sure that everything is labeled if it is necessary to bring an item to camp. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES, SUCH AS TABLETS, PERSONAL GAMING DEVICES, CELL PHONES, ETC., ARE PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES AND WILL BE TAKEN FROM THE CAMPER AND RETURNED AT THE END OF THE DAY.**

### **\*\*\*SCHEDULE CHANGES\*\*\***

Any changes that need to be made to a camper’s schedule must be made by the Wednesday of the week **BEFORE** the needed change. Families with more than one child in Summer Camp will be not allowed to switch weeks between children. Each child needs to be registered individually.

## **DRESS CODE**

Please keep in mind the following guidelines as you select your child's clothing for summer camp. The most important thing is to keep cool and comfortable in the hot weather we will experience!

### **GUYS**

1. Shorts and pants are permitted.
2. A shirt must be worn at all times. Sleeveless shirts are acceptable. If slogan shirts are worn, please keep them to an athletic theme. Undershirts **MAY NOT** be worn as outerwear.
3. Tennis shoes are a **MUST!! Sandals or Flip Flops may be worn on swim days only.**
4. Hair should be neat and trimmed.

### **GIRLS**

1. Girls will be permitted to wear shorts that are modest in length. They may wear slacks (blue jeans are acceptable), and skorts. No skirts please.
2. Modest tank tops are acceptable. Please refrain from short or crop tops, tie shirts, and spaghetti straps.
3. Girls will need a one-piece bathing suit or tankini that covers her stomach.
4. Tennis shoes are a **MUST!! Sandals or Flip Flops may be worn on swim days only.**

Your child's counselor/director will determine immodest attire. Parents will be contacted to bring alternate clothing if needed.

### **\*\*\*CAMP T-SHIRTS\*\*\***

**\*\*\*\*Camp T-Shirts** are to be worn anytime campers leave Northside Property. If an additional shirt must be given to your child to attend a field trip, your account will be charged for a new shirt. Campers will not be permitted to leave campus without their T-Shirt.

**Additional T-Shirts** - Please indicate on your registration form how many shirts you would like. You will receive one with your paid registration. Any additional shirts need to be paid for with the registration fee.

# DISCIPLINE POLICY

## WE DO:

- We rely on positive reinforcement and praise. We want to catch your children doing well.
- We reward desirable behavior.
- We distract children from undesirable behavior by re-directing them to something more positive.
- We use time out as a next step. The teacher will make sure that the child understands why he/she is being put in time out, and then given time away from the group activity to calm down and reconsider their actions.
- We may, as a last resort, call you to come to the center to discipline your child within one hour.
- We deny the privilege of attending field trips and Summer Camp to children who do not respond to the methods listed above.
- We rely heavily on contact with you, as a parent. If there is a behavior problem, we will contact you and ask for your assistance.

## WE DO NOT:

- Spank or otherwise physically punish the children.
- Make fun of, yell at, or otherwise verbally abuse the children.
- Shame or punish the children when bathroom accidents occur.
- Deny meals or rest as punishment.
- Leave the children alone or without supervision.
- Allow discipline of children by other children or another child's parent.
- Criticize, make fun of, or otherwise belittle children's families or ethnic groups.

## **SNACK / LUNCH POLICIES & PROCEDURES**

**Morning snacks** will be provided each day. Your child will have a choice of milk or juice with the provided snack.

**Lunch** may be purchased in our cafeteria or you may bring lunch from home.

**Afternoon snacks** will be provided each day. Your child may bring an additional snack from home.

**Debit System** - Camper's pay for their lunch in the cafeteria through the school's debit system. To place money on your child's Café Account, go to NCA Online at <http://www.ncaknights.com/quick-links> and select NCA Cafe' payment option.

**Lunch Cost - \$3.70**

Even if you plan for your child to bring his/her lunch each day, it is wise to put in enough money in the account for one day's lunch cost in the event your child forgets his/her lunch. Money will not be taken out of the account, unless your child purchases a lunch from the cafeteria.
