**Communication:**

RenWeb, NCA's information software system, will continue to provide the most up-to-date information regarding grades, attendance, homework, directory information, finances, and discipline referrals. **Make sure that you maintain a current email address in RenWeb.** You can do this through your Parent's Web Account. Northside continues to use email as a main source of communication with you. Teachers will contact you through RenWeb or use of their own classroom homepage. Look for weekly updates from your child's teachers, the school office, and my office.

**Finances:**

Before school begins, please make sure that you have finalized all of your financial obligations. At the end of each quarter you will receive a reminder to check your financial balance for tuition, fees, and cafeteria charges. You will be asked to keep these current. Please review your statement from the Business Office each month.

Soon, you will be directed to a link to the NCA Parent/Student Handbook. Note that some changes have been made, and it is important to familiarize your family with the contents of the handbook. The annual Back-to-School Orientation will be held **August 14 at 6:30 pm** in the main auditorium of Northside Baptist Church. Please make plans to be there. After our meeting time, you will have a chance to meet your child's teacher or find your child's classrooms in the middle and high school. Students in grades K5-5 grade may drop-off school supplies in their homeroom class. Students in grades 6 -12 may drop-off school supplies in their lockers. Class assignments for grades K5-5 and class schedules and locker information for grades 6-12 will be communicated to you prior to August 14.

## **Dress Code Policies**

*Effective August 2018*

NCA students must wear the following every day, with the exception of Friday Spirit Days, school-determined Casual Days, or any other day specifically designated as a day when the dress code may be altered, such as Spirit Week, athletic dress up days, etc.

### Elementary

- red, black, or white collared Land's End uniform shirt with the current monogrammed school logo
- appropriately fitted khaki or black uniform style pants or shorts (no denim material, cotton/yoga/exercise style or cargo-style shorts or pants)
- shoes (no flip flops)

### Middle School

- solid color polo shirt
- appropriately fitted khaki or black uniform style pants or shorts (no denim material, cotton/yoga/exercise style or cargo-style shorts or pants)
- shoes

### High School

- shirt with sleeves (tee shirts and sweat shirts must be solid color with no words, pictures or graphics on them)
- pants with no holes or tears (no writing on pants; no jeggings or other tight-fitting pants)
- shoes
- A red polo shirt may be required on special days such as field trips.

### General Guidelines

## **Dress Code Policies (cont.)**

*Effective August 2018*

- All students should be modest and neat at all times. Boys' pants must be pulled up at all times. (If a student's pants are too big, he should wear a belt to keep them up!) Students should refrain from wearing clothes that are too tight.
- Fridays are Spirit Days. Students may wear jeans and a school spirit shirt. High school students must wear a solid red, black or white shirt, or a spirit shirt on Spirit Days.
- On Casual Days, students may wear tee shirts or sweat shirts. These should be free from abusive, suggestive, or profane language or graphics. Students should refrain from wearing clothing which represents secular artists.
- Students are required to wear shoes at all time for health and safety reasons.
- Hats may not be worn in the building during the school day. (This includes the hood on a hoodie.)

### Hair

- Boys must wear their hair in a style that does not obstruct vision or hinder participation in the learning process. Hairstyles may not be a distraction.
- Boys may have facial hair as long as it is neat, but may be requested to be clean shaven for special events or performances.
- Girls must wear their hair in a style that does not obstruct vision or hinder participation in the learning process.

### Jewelry

Jewelry may not be overstated, questionable, or anti-Christian. Students may not wear spiked jewelry, gang symbols, Gothic attire, dental grills, or wallet chains. Body piercings other than ear piercings are not acceptable.

### Tattoos

If a student has a tattoo, he must keep it covered at all times while at school or any school event.

*If a student comes to school in clothing that is not neat, modest, and in accordance with the school dress code, he may not be able to go to class until he has changed clothes and is in accordance with the dress code. On the second offense and every offense thereafter, that student may receive a detention.*

**Details:**

- Each parent who wishes to sell their school uniforms will be responsible for managing their own table. Tables will be provided for you. You will need to stay with your table in order to sell your uniforms
- Your uniforms must be clearly marked in size and cost (usually half the cost of new or less depending on condition  
Provide your own cash box (Please, small bills only (1's, 5's and 10s) as change for larger bills will not be available)  
Organize your clothing by sizes and items on the table
- Provide signage to let purchasers know if your clothing is for elementary, middle or high school
- Uniforms must be clean with no spots, holes or tears; they should be in consignment condition
- Uniform polo's must have the current logo on them
- No cargo pants, jeans or non- uniform clothing may be sold
- No cost for use of the facility or table
- Must clean up your own space (no clothing, pins, papers, trash) with the table clear when you leave
- Bring plastic bags, if possible, for sale items



## Private Lesson Registration Form

### Lesson Policies and Considerations

**Students will need to have an instrument of their own on which to practice.**

**Lessons will begin the week after Labor Day.** An instructor will contact you with a lesson time and further instructions. Class schedules may change some during the first month of school, which may require lesson schedule changes. Please be patient as we work out any issues.

**A \$20 non-refundable registration fee will be assessed for each student registering.** This amount will be charged to the student's family account.

**Lessons are \$22.50 per half hour of instruction.** For your convenience, we have multiplied the lesson rate by 30 lessons (given over the course of the school year) to arrive at a payment amount of \$70 a month. This means that you need not be concerned on a monthly basis about number of lessons in the month, as 30 lessons will be given between September and May. **Payment is due to the teacher the first lesson of the month. If payment is not received by the second lesson of the month lessons may be discontinued until payment is made.**

**Now offering group voice lessons for Elementary students.** Lessons will be \$15.00 per half hour instruction. We have multiplied the lesson rate by 30 lessons (given over the course of the school year) to arrive at a payment amount of \$50.00 a month.

**One full year of lessons will be required for private lesson students.** If you decide to discontinue lessons before the end of the school year, you will be expected to pay for the remainder of the term. We will certainly work with individuals who have extenuating circumstances.

**Every effort will be made to assign students to the teacher of their choice,** but scheduling conflicts and teacher availability will be factors.

**Make-up lessons or lesson credit are only given due to instructor absence.** Every effort will be made to accommodate school scheduling conflicts that arise, but parents will be expected to communicate this information with the teacher in advance. A parent should not assume that it is the teacher's responsibility to know every student's schedule, changes, or events. Our teacher's schedules are very full, thus making it difficult to accommodate last-minute schedule changes.

Group lessons, master classes, or recital rehearsals may count towards the 30 lessons.

RE: ASBESTOS AWARENESS LETTER

Federal law requires that every school, including Northside Christian Academy (NCA), report annually as to the presence of asbestos in the school's facilities. Experts certified in asbestos abatement have verified that the school has small quantities of asbestos in some of its building materials, in some buildings on campus, but their inspection reports that the asbestos is in such small quantities as to present virtually no health risk to employees or students.

NCA implemented its management plan on August 19, 1988 and has been conducting periodic surveillance of all asbestos-containing building materials. This periodic surveillance and inspection are conducted to provide a continuous assessment to assure safety conscious management of asbestos-containing materials.

The detailed plan and updated information for each building and the entire school is open to public review.

## KIDZONE FINANCIAL POLICY

Kidzone PM Registration Fee - \$60 a year

KIDZONE MONTHLY ENROLLMENT: New NCA School policy requires all students attend supervised care if dropped off early or left late. Even in an emergency, Kidzone provides that care, not the Elementary Office or the classroom teacher. As of June 1, 2018, NCA is requiring a yearly contract by all Kidzone attendees along with a \$60 Kidzone PM yearly registration. Credits will not be given for extracurricular activities such as Elementary play or school clubs.

Kidzone AM CHARGES: AM Charges are weekly, not daily. To avoid AM charges, students must be dropped off after 7:30 AM, or pay \$25 for that week's before school care.

Kidzone PM Monthly CHARGES: Kidzone after school care and early school dismissal will be billed on a monthly basis and requires a contract and registration fee. Payment will be required on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.

Kidzone PM without a contract: Drop ins to NCA Kidzone PM will be billed \$30 for the 1<sup>st</sup> day and given a paper contract to sign. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of attendance the fee will be \$75 for the week and another paper contract given to parent to sign. Further attendance will incur the monthly fee and another paper contract given to parent to sign.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS: Pre-registration via Parents Web/ Web form is required for School Holiday Kidzone attendance. You must cancel your reservations in writing to [caitlin.leopard@northsidecharlotte.com](mailto:caitlin.leopard@northsidecharlotte.com) 48 business hours prior to the event to be released from the Cancellation fee of \$10.

PAYMENTS: Parents may access their family's account balance via the school's website [www.Renweb.com](http://www.Renweb.com). Online payments may be made on line at [NCAKNIGHTS.com](http://NCAKNIGHTS.com) / quicklinks / Online payment. Please choose NCA Fees Acctg. System to pay your Kidzone balance. Checks and Cash may be made at the AEL or NCA Business office. It is important to note your Family Id and child's name on payment. Never place cash in the drop box.

Withdrawal: If the Kidzone monthly fee is unpaid by the next billing cycle, the student will be withdrawn from the NCA Kidzone program. Parents will need to find alternative care for their child for after school care. Parents enrolled in the NCA Kidzone Monthly program can do a 1x withdraw per school year. Withdraw is required 10 days before the end of the month without penalty. Reenrollment to the program or Reattendance will incur a \$50 re-enrollment fee along with the regular monthly fee.

LATE PAYMENTS: Late payment incurs a \$10 fee per student. Access to ParentsWeb, report cards and school records may be withheld for delinquent payments.

TAX REPORTING/RECEIPTS: Please use your online statements through ParentsWeb or cancelled checks or cash receipts for tax reporting. Our TAX I.D. NO. is 56-0787452.
