



Dear International Agency or Prospective Family:

I would like to thank you for your interest in Northside Christian Academy. Your interest in a Christian education is commendable. Beyond academic excellence, Northside Christian Academy endeavors to touch the hearts of our students. We do find host families for our international students; the monthly host family stipend is \$900. Below is a list of directions on how to apply to NCA for an international student. International students must have approval from our International office prior to submitting an on-line application. **All new international students must arrive in Charlotte no later than August 10, 2019 so they can take their Admissions test and prepare for the start of school.**

Step I: Submit the following documents via email to pamela.starkey@northsidecharlotte.com

- Last two years of grades, including grading scale (translated)
- Math, English and Administrator's Recommendation (Grades 7-12)

Step II: Schedule a Skype Interview

- Please email to schedule a Skype interview, interviews are conducted U.S. (EST) time.
- Skype ID: momstarkey

Step III: Submit additional required admissions documents

- Immunization record
- Passport
- Health Insurance Card

Step IV: Submit an INTERNATIONAL On-Line Application at ncaknights.com/Admissions

- The on-line Application includes the Tuition Payment Contract, Family Covenant, \$300 Registration Fee and \$150 New Student Testing Fee (both fees are non-refundable).

Step V: Admissions Testing

- As part of the admissions process, Northside administers an Assessment Test to all new students. International students must take this test on our campus in early August.

Step VI: Interview with Principal

Lastly, the student's guardian will be contacted to schedule a host parent/student interview. At least one host parent (preferably both) must be present at the interview. This interview will consist of: reviewing the Student Application and Assessment Results; acquainting each guardian/student with our school policies; explaining the specifics of the respective grade-level curriculum.
